Re: **Boy Scouts of America Jamboree 2010**

It has recently come to our attention that the Boy Scouts of America have further extended their invitation to our members to attend their national Jamboree in July, 2010.

The BSA had previously allotted us a total of 50 spaces to fill with interested members from Scouts Canada. This was broken down into 5 patrols (males only) of 10 participants, consisting of 8 youth and 2 adults each.

To ensure that we have good representation from across the country we offered these positions on a first come first served basis. Now that we have the opportunity to send more youth and we have a limited time to respond, we are prepared to accept full patrols if there is sufficient interest.

As the BSA is now offering us the opportunity to attend this event with a larger, full Canadian Contingent, I ask that you please notify any potential interested participants of this new development at your earliest convenience.

The original deadline for deposit payment (US \$400/participant) for this event was February 15th, 2010; we are now pushing this deadline back and will notify you when further arrangements have been made. Full payment will be a \$795 fee to be paid in US currency.
