WOW! For the first time Camp Lone Cloud is offering **“A Taste of Camp”** to Beaver Scouts! Six 9-hour day camps will be offered to registered Beaver Scouts. Those attending will experience **“A Taste of Camp”** including songs, games, swimming, camp meals, a ride in the new Don Dorey boat and take part in some of our theme week’s wacky theme skits, as well as Water Day activities. Camp takes place rain or shine.

The themes this year are:

Week 1 – Western Week - July 12: Infamous outlaw Wild Joe Crockett and his posse show up at Camp Lone Cloud to enact a train robbery and hold a staff member hostage. Camp Lone calls in old western hero, Wayne Johnson, to save the day but in his old age he has become rusty and Camp Lone Cloud has to help him save the day and stop Crockett.

Week 2 – Space Week - July 19: Camp Lone Cloud receives a signal from aliens in outer space requesting to land on the island to refuel and repair their ship. Excited to be the first humans to meet extraterrestrials, Camp Lone Cloud extends a friendly welcome but when a secret government agency hears of the news they show up to camp with their own plans.

Week 3 – CLC Goes Under the Sea - July 26: Fishermen on Miller Lake start discovering a number of ocean creatures appearing in the lake. Camp Lone Cloud and a marine biologist start looking into why ocean creatures would start swimming in fresh water. However, a group of fishermen start hunting all the creatures for profit and Camp Lone Cloud must find a way to save them before it is too late.

Week 4 – CLC Goes Jurassic - August 2: A time portal opens up at camp and dinosaurs start appearing on the island! A group of scientists and archeologists come to camp to research the dinosaurs. However, Camp Lone Cloud begins to suspect they have other motives when they begin talking about opening a dinosaur zoo on the Island.

Week 5 – Mystery Week - August 9: When items and a staff member go missing on the Island and clues begin surfacing as to their whereabouts, Camp Lone Cloud must solve the mystery of the kidnapped staff member by discovering the who, what, where, when and why!

Week 6 – Music Week - August 16: A group of concert promoters become interested in camp as a big summer festival venue! Soon lots of crazy promoters, managers and musicians show up to convince Camp Lone Cloud
